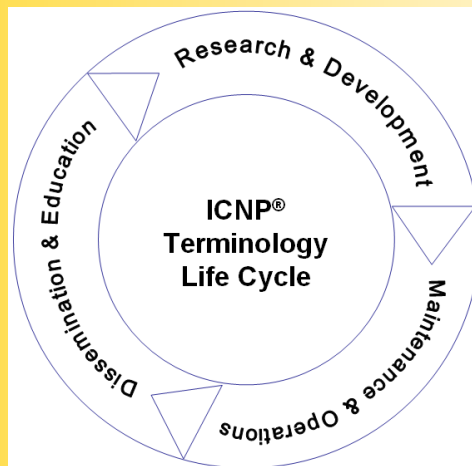
ICNP Strategic Goals

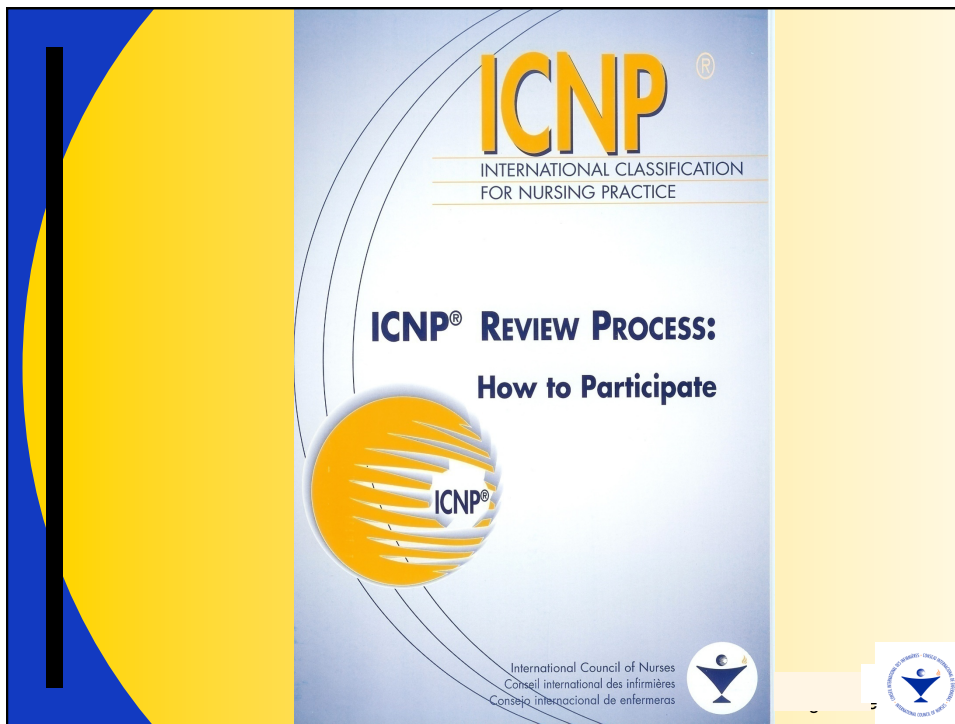
